Commissioners Workshop

The Campbell County Board of Commissioners met for a Commissioners Workshop, Thursday, September 11, 2008 at 8:00 AM.

Present were Dan Coolidge, Roy Edwards, Amir Sancher, Chris Knapp and Craig Mader, Commissioners; Maxine Lieber, Deputy County Clerk; Carol Seeger, Deputy County Attorney; Jackie Clough, Senior Administrative Assistant and Robert Palmer, Commissioners Administrative Director.

The Commissioners gave their Board Liaison reports, reviewed the upcoming calendar of events and discussed the agenda items for the September 15, 2008 regular meeting.

Commissioner Mader moved to approve up to \$250.00 in capital contingency for the Cooperative Extension Service to purchase a new chair. Commissioner Edwards seconded the motion.
