RE: Passenger Facility Charge Program (PFC) – Gillette-Campbell County Airport (GCC)

To Whom It May Concern:

This letter serves as the notice to air carriers that the Gillette-Campbell County Airport Board intends to submit an “Impose and Use” PFC application to the FAA. PFC authorizing legislation requires that information on the program be conveyed to the airlines **and that the airlines respond to the airport, in writing, acknowledging receipt of the required notice.**

The proposed projects are:

- Construct Apron
- Acquire Development Land
- PFC Administration

The proposed projects for PFC funding in this “impose and use,” application are more particularly described on the enclosed page.

The airport is currently charging the maximum PFC allowable of \$4.50 per enplaned passenger and plans to continue collecting this amount for the projects listed above. The proposed charge effective date is November 1, 2007. The estimated expiration date is July 1, 2009. The estimated PFC revenue is \$167,238.

The Gillette-Campbell County Airport Board is requesting to exempt all air taxi/commercial operators filing FAA Form 1800-31 from collection of the PFC. The known carrier in this class is Flightline, Inc. The estimated number of passengers enplaned by this class is less than 100. The Gillette-Campbell County Airport Board desires to exempt this class of carriers because the administrative costs for the carrier and the airport are considered excessive for the small amount of revenue received.

In accordance with Federal Aviation Regulation 49 CFR Part 158.23, Consultation with air carriers and foreign air carriers, the Gillette-Campbell County Airport Board will hold a consultation meeting with air carriers on July 30, 2007, at 2:00 p.m. in the Airport Conference Room at the Gillette-Campbell County Airport Terminal Building, Gillette, Wyoming. Air carriers will have 30 days to present any objections to this application in writing from the date of this meeting. Certifications of agreement/disagreement shall be sent to Mr. Jay Lundell, Airport Executive Director, Gillette-Campbell County Airport, 2000 Airport Road, Suite 108, Gillette, Wyoming 82716, jay@ccgov.net. If no response is received within 30 days, it will be considered as a certification of agreement.
