Commissioners Workshop

The Campbell County Board of Commissioners met for a Commissioners Workshop, Thursday, June 27, 2019 at 8:00 AM.

Present were Rusty Bell, Del Shelstad, Bob Maul, Commissioners; Susan F. Commissioners Mark Christensen and DG Reardon were absent from the meeting.

The Commissioners gave their Board Liaison reports.

Robert Palmer, Commissioners Administrative Director, discussed the agenda items for the July 2, 2019 regular meeting and reviewed the calendar of upcoming events and meetings.

Quade Schmelzle, Weed and Pest Director, and Faye Mackey discussed bulbous bluegrass and county reclamation.

The Commissioners met with Jim Ford for a regulatory update.


It was the consensus of the Commissioners to approve an additional capital request for a shop cooler fan for the Landfill.
