Northeast Wyoming Regional Airport Jay Lundell Director's Report June 17, 2020

1. Airport statistics

Total passengers for May were 770 compared to 224 passengers in April. Advanced bookings are gradually increasing for each month. Starting in July SkyWest will discontinue our tag with Sheridan. We'll be back to our own daily flight. As advanced bookings increase, SkyWest will add-in a second flight.

United continues to only have two daily banks in and out of Denver International Airport compared to five daily banks pre-COVID-19.

2. Tower closure

The control tower permanently closed June 4th. We'd originally planned for July 1st but unfortunate circumstances forced its premature permanent closure.

3. Operations personnel

The airport is now fully staffed with a total of five (5) operations personnel, operations supervisor Tod Love, and operations director Todd Chatfield.

4. Wyoming Airport Operators Association

Gillette was scheduled to host this year's Fall conference, but because of COVID-19 this year's conference has been cancelled. Next year's conference will be held in Casper. Gillette can apply to be the conference host in 2022.

5. Next airport board meeting

The next airport board meeting is scheduled for July 15th and will be a quarterly meeting with the County Commissioners.
