The hearing was called to order by
CARE Board Chairwoman, Michelle Butler at 1:02 p.m.

A copy of the CSBG allocation and distribution of funds to service providers was dispersed to all attendees for review.

CSBG is a block grant calculated by formula based on the community needs assessment (performed every three years); the FY19 Campbell County CSBG distribution is \$215,668. The distribution is broken down into nine categories: Education, Emergency Services, Employment, Health, Housing, Income Management, Linkages, Nutrition, and Self-Sufficiency. Six agencies, including the CARE Board, will be receiving CSBG funding for FY19.

The distribution is as follows:

- CARE Board : \$19,668
- Council of Community Services : \$90,000
- Gillette Abuse Refuge Foundation : \$22,000
- Gillette Reproductive Health : \$28,000
- Personal Frontiers : \$31,000
- Youth Emergency Services : \$25,000
- TOTAL : \$215,668
