## **Coordinators Teleconference**

Jim reported that CST wanted everyone to stay safe and do as the county advised. There are still no contracts as some are still at the AGs office. The state is currently working on a cost analysis of treatment costs by county in order to make more accurate formulas to determine costs. If you get an email from them regarding this it is legitimate. Virtual site visits will be in August, everyone on the team must participate.

## **Budget Update**

Jim reported that Megan Kincaid-Heidel sent out the workbook to track expenses and asked for questions. He also reported that we will be receiving, conditionally, \$10,000 from the City 1% for Mental Health Treatment for YIT, \$8,100 from CARE Board for Mental Health Treatment for YIT, about \$36,000 in Cash match with the approval of the application and that will have \$20,000 going to Mental Health Treatment for YIT. Jim also reported that we are still waiting for official confirmation from CJSB and the contract from CST.

## **MAT Policy**

Megan emailed out 3 documents that Char Edwards worked on and used to create the MAT Policy. Jim spoke with Sheridan who utilizes MAT and had no juvenile using MAT at this time, but three of 30 adults were using it. YES House will not do MAT but if kids come and need it they will work with a provider. MAT is not encouraged for juveniles. Board members were asked to look at those documents and write down questions to talk and hopefully finalize the policy at the next board meeting.

## **Treatment Representative Vacancy**

Jamie Hurich reported that she spoke with the Odecovens and they turned down the offer to be the treatment representative. Jamie also left two messages with the other hopeful and has not heard back at this time.

## **Other Business**

Jim reminded everyone that the NADCP Virtual Conference was coming up and to be on the look out for the sign in information. Jim also proposed a special event for the recognition for the kids concerning medals and other accomplishments during the virtual court hearings.

Kim Hoff said courts are not open even though the courthouse is open. Supreme court reviewed things and no jury trials will be set until 8/3/2020, if judges within the county have a plan then they can move to in person. Philips and Rumpke are working and hopefully will be done with a plan outline by the end of the day.

The next meeting is June 16<sup>th</sup>, 2020.
