Directors Workshop

The Campbell County Board of Commissioners met for a Directors Workshop, Monday, August 5, 2019 at 1:00 PM.

Present were Rusty Bell, Mark Christensen, DG Reardon, Del Shelstad, Bob Maul, Commissioners; Kendra Anderson, Deputy County Clerk; Carol Seeger, Deputy County Attorney; Kevin Geis, Road and Bridge Director; Tina Crider-Honeycutt, HR/Risk Management Specialist; Kevin King, Public Works Director and Ivy McGowan-Castleberry, Public Information Coordinator.

Commissioner Shelstad moved to convene into executive session to discuss personnel. Commissioner Maul seconded the motion. All Voted-Aye. Carried.

The Board reconvened into the Directors Workshop at 1:40 PM.

Discussion was held with Fire Chief Bender on a position allocation for a 40 hour/week administrative assistant.

Discussion was held with Jay Lundell, Airport Director, regarding commercial air service.

Tina Crider-Honeycutt, HR/Risk Management Specialist, provided updates on health care expenses, employee picnic attendance, the open Commissioners Administrative Director position, employee performance appraisals, wellness screenings and open enrollment.

Kevin Geis, Road and Bridge Director, discussed roads in the Los Caballos Improvement and Service District and provided updates on mowing in right-a-ways, the Adon Road railroad crossing, the North Garner Lake Road phase I and II and the 2020 CMAQ application.

Chairman Rusty Bell provided updates on the several local tours and the open Human Resources Director opening.

Kevin King, Public Works Director, discussed the pointing of the Human Resources Director.

Discussion was held with Clark Melinkovich, Staff Engineer, and Rick Mansur, Parks and Recreation Director, on the new soccer field and sidewalks for the field. It was the consensus of the Board to do a change order and add sidewalks instead of sod to the south and west sides.

Discussion was held with Clark Melinkovich on the sewer issues at the Sheriff's Office. It was suggested to request \$60,000 in contingency for the repair costs.

Discussion was held on reducing the amount of perimeter litter fencing for the landfill and

instead purchase containers for the North Landfill with the funds not used for the fencing.

Kevin King provided updates on the water, at Bryan's Place, being monitored by DEQ.

Discussion was held on hail damage on county property.

Discussion was held on a PGI sponsorship. It was the consensus of the Board not to provide a sponsorship.

There being no further business to come before the Commissioners, the meeting was adjourned at 3:05 PM.
