Special Meeting

The Campbell County Board of Commissioners met in a Special Meeting, Thursday, May 12, 2021 at 9:00AM.

The purpose of the Special Meeting was to discuss library operation to include the library collection development policy, the collection challenge process and training programs, and ratification of Amended Order Levying Requisite Taxes for the Fiscal Year 2021/2022.
