

A new 4-H 101 Club has been created to allow new members to learn about 4-H. Kim will be attending the National Conference virtually and working on Rec Mill Grants. Kim presented an updated proposal from the Livestock Committee for a Born and Raised in Campbell County Class at County Fair. Kim discussed the attached proposal with the Fair Board. Fair Coordinator ~

Liz reported she attended the Wyoming Association of Fairs' fall meeting September 29th – October 2nd in Jackson Hole, WY. Many topics were discussed at the meeting regarding how other Fairs were conducted differently due to the current circumstances and restrictions with COVID-19, and how their Boards and Families handle the rules/guidelines of their fitting/caring policies. She is gathering information regarding their carcass classes and Bred and Fed programs. Liz has designed an advertisement for the 100th year celebration collecting photos, artifact, etc. that will be in the County Newsletter and 4-H Flash. Liz is contacting entertainment representatives to check for availability during our Fair dates.

Old Business ~

Liz reported both Fair conventions (RMAF and IAFE) have been canceled due to low attendees with the effects of COVID-19. IAFE is offering a virtual option for a fee and Liz asked the Board to notify her if they are interested. The flights previously purchased in 2019 are valid until October of 2021.
