**RESOLUTION ON INTENDED USE OF REVENUES  
FROM OPTIONAL ONE PERCENT SALES TAX**

**WHEREAS**, the voters of Campbell County are considering renewal of the local optional one percent sales tax; and

**WHEREAS**, the citizens of Campbell County have been surveyed regarding the expenditure of the revenues raised by the local optional one percent sales tax and have expressed their priorities for expenditures; and

**WHEREAS**, the Campbell County Board of County Commissioners support the tax and wish to express its present intention as to uses of the revenues;


**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED** that the Campbell County Board of County Commissioners intend to use the revenues raised by the local optional one percent sales tax if it is approved by the voters for January 1, 2003 through December 31, 2006, for expenditures in the following categories:

1. County Roads
2. Emergency & Safety Equipment
3. Economic Development Programs
4. Youth Programs & Equipment
5. Senior Citizens' Programs
6. Capital Facilities Maintenance & Repair
7. Capital Replacement Reserve
8. Catastrophic Fire Suppression
9. Bike Path/Beautification Project Development & Maintenance
10. Grants to Human Service Providers
11. Landfill/Recycling Operations
12. Improvement & Service District Grants Program
