


Survey Demographics Place of Residence


**Survey Demographics

- We shouldn't be spending so much on beautification, there are higher priorities. Gillette is a very beautiful town. Roads are shitty though.
- We are fortunate to have the resources available to do a lot of good things for our Community.
- Widow - living on fixed income - beginning to think that Gillette is getting to be too expensive for people on fixed incomes. Will probably have to move within the next 10 years.

-Why is there such a desire to make Gillette a big city with all the problems that go with it. I liked it much better when the town was smaller and there weren't so many strangers. We seem to have a lot of people just here for the money and they don't care about trying to make this a better community. A lot don't even want to know who their neighbors are. Also, I see no need to worry about bringing more businesses in when they can't staff what we have now.

-City and County did not seem to follow the water restrictions as well as the public. Waste of money painting top light posts on 4-J. A lot of city streets need resurfaced rather than alleys. Streets like E. 5th by Rolling Hills trailer court need city attention.

-Please reuse the one percent sales tax signs. They are very expensive over \$100 each, maybe utilizing a rotating system.

-My assumption of the one percent tax is for optional things (park upgrades, bike paths, more emergency upgrade equipment). Don't we pay property taxes for necessary things (pave streets, sidewalks, police,

fire department, etc.)? And doesn't the money we pay for water and sewer go to pay for water and sewer.
