- Computer Generated (all ages)

Submit art to Campbell County Public Library or Wright Branch Library no later than 4:30pm February 26, 2021. Entries must be original – they cannot be traced or copied from another artist's work. All characters become property of The Library Foundation Inc. Original entries returned upon request for artist portfolio use only, must be picked up by June 1, 2021.

Guidelines:

- Original not copyrighted
 - Library appropriate
 - Computer Generated must be printed
 - Entries may be submitted on the back of this form or a separate sheet no larger than 8.5" X 14".
- Entries failing to meet these guidelines will be automatically disqualified. Bonus for incorporating the Campbell County Public Library System logo.

- Overall winner: \$50 gift card and their work featured as 2021 CCPLS Graphic Novel Character
- People's Choice: \$25 in art supplies • Votes cast at CCPL and on Facebook.
