



Community Stores with Exceptions for Elderly and People with Needs

As COVID-19 surrounds us, we have seen Campbell County businesses and stores work hard to make sure everyone has the items they need. Many stores have started to limit how much can be bought at once, while others have went further to assist the elderly population and people with special needs. Below is a list of stores who are attempting to help elderly and other populations.

- Albertson's – Albertsons is holding back a portion of each toilet paper shipment it receives. This stock is reserved for seniors. Seniors should approach the front desk and ask for “toilet paper for seniors.” There is a limit of one package per senior.
- Smith's – Starting 03/23/2020, Smith's will open an hour early on Monday's, Wednesday's, and Friday's for seniors to shop. Only seniors will be allowed in during this hour.
- Norco – Norco is attempting to deliver available toilet paper to any elderly who may not be able to make it to the store. Call Norco to inquire about their supplies if you are unable to make it to a store.
- Family Dollar – Family Dollar is holding a portion of their stock back for elderly people. Elderly are encouraged to ask the front desk for available products.

It should be noted the stores listed above cannot guarantee they will have items in stock. Don's Supermarket, Walgreen's, Menard's, and many other stores in our community are doing their best to cater to people who may need extra assistance. Although these stores are helping senior citizens, they are also assisting other groups like pregnant mothers and parents of small children. If you are in need, approach staff to enquire about their available supplies and how they might be able to help you. The stores above did not have a minimum age of what they considered elderly and each store will handle requests on a case by case basis. Most of all, please avoid, “panic buying.” Campbell County is a strong community and together we will help each other through COVID-19!
