



## 2020 Virtual Chalk Art Contest Entry Form

Campbell County Public Library (CCPL) is hosting a virtual chalk art contest with a road trip/automotive theme in conjunction with our upcoming Ride & Read Car Show. Entries are due by 4:30pm on Saturday, August 29 and will be on display in the CCPL atrium and on Facebook from Monday, August 31 -Saturday, September 5. Winners will be announced September 8.

**To Enter:** Artists are invited to enter their creation in either the Individual category or the Team category if two or more artists collaborate on one piece. **Submit a photo of your chalk art and this entry form in person at CCPL’s Reference Desk or by emailing them to paula@ccpls.org no later than 4:30pm August 29.** Entries must be original – they cannot be traced or copied from another artist's work. All photos become property of CCPL.

**Guidelines:** Find a chunk of concrete that you are allowed to draw on and create an original “library appropriate” chalk art piece inspired by road trips/automotive. Only allowed medium is water-based chalk on concrete or other paved surface. Entries that fail to meet this guideline will be automatically disqualified. Please submit this form along with a photo of your entry as a .jpg or .png file or printed picture. If entering the Team category, each artist must complete an entry form and submit it with the photo of the artwork.

**Prizes:**

- Contest winners are invited to chalk a chunk of concrete at our Ride & Read Car Show on September 12, as well as have their artwork featured at the event.
- Entries will be showcased in an exhibit in the CCPL atrium and on Facebook August 31 -September 5. Winners will be determined by the public who will vote in two ways: anonymous ballot after viewing the entries on display in the CCPL atrium and by “liking” their favorite entry on Facebook. Both displays will feature all entries.

By signing this form, the artist/parent/guardian of the artist verifies that the entry is an original creation by the artist(s) named below. Further, the artist/parent/guardian transfers all rights, titles and interest in their entry to CCPL to utilize at their sole discretion, including allowing it to be posted to social media. **Artists under 18 must have a legal guardian sign below.**
