

CAMPBELL COUNTY SMOKING POLICY

RESOLUTION NUMBER 1826

AMENDED

WHEREAS, the Board of Campbell County Commissioners is committed to protecting the health, safety and welfare of the public and employees of Campbell County who utilize County facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Occupational Safety and Health Act have regulations governing smoking and ventilation in the workplace, and the County is subject to those regulations;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners, Campbell County, Wyoming, this 6th day of May, 2014, that:

- (1) No one can smoke or carry any lighted smoking instrument in a Campbell County facility or at a public meeting in county facilities, except in areas specifically designated as permitted smoking areas.
- (2) Anyone persisting in smoking contrary to the terms of this policy, after an oral or written request or warning to cease smoking, shall be deemed to be in violation of this policy.
- (3) In cases of County employees, a violation of this policy shall result in disciplinary action by the appropriate department head and could ultimately result in suspension or termination from employment.
- (4) For purposes of this policy, the following definitions shall apply:
 - (a) Campbell County Facilities – means any enclosed building or structure that is owned and operated by Campbell County, which includes, but is not limited to, the Campbell County Courthouse, the Recreation Center, the Library, the Detention Center which includes both administrative and jail facilities, the Public Health office, the Landfill office, the Road & Bridge office, the Bicentennial Park maintenance buildings, the Bell Nob Clubhouse, the Campbell County Children’s Developmental Services facilities, the Gillette-Campbell County Airport, the George Amos Memorial Building, and the Museum.
 - (b) Smoke or smoking – means the act of burning any tobacco product, weed filler or plant of any kind in a cigarette, cigar, pipe or other smoking device, including any product that employs any mechanical heating element battery or electronic circuit .
 - (c) Smoking instrument – means any cigarette, cigar, pipe, electronic cigarette, vaporizer or other smoking device.
- (5) Smoking shall not be permitted and smoking areas shall not be designated, in those county areas where smoking is prohibited by the Fire Chief, state statute, ordinances or regulations of the City of Gillette, Campbell County, State of Wyoming or other applicable laws. Nothing herein shall be interpreted so as to permit smoking where it is otherwise restricted by law.

(6) This policy shall become effective May 6, 2014. Building directors, managers and supervisors shall be responsible for the implementation of this policy including:

- (a) Communication of this policy to county employees and the general public.
- (b) The posting of appropriate signs in county buildings as deemed necessary.






