Baker entry deadline: April 1, 2017

14 spaces available. First come, first served. Once spaces are filled, your name will be placed on a cancellation list and you will be called if space becomes available.

Location: Campbell County Public Library • 2101 S. 4J Road

Setup: Friday, April 7, 9am-4:45pm and
Saturday, April 8, 9am-1pm (setup must be complete
1/2 hour prior to doors opening to allow for judging)

- Objective: Make a tasty cupcake, decorate your table and area, impress the judges, and win a great prize!**
- Cupcakes and frosting should be made from scratch -- no box mixes, please. They should be made prior to the contest and need no refrigeration. Bakers are allowed one flavor of cupcake per entry, per table. Tables are 8 foot rectangles. Cupcakes will be judged by guest judges and the public using the following criteria:
 - Taste
 - Presentation (including table decorations); optional theme: Old West
- Please bring 25 dozen mini size or 7 dozen regular size cupcakes (slice regular in quarters for more "tastes") for People's Choice tasting. Napkins, plates, forks provided by CCPL.
- Please set aside 5 cupcakes for the guest judges. Judge's Choice Awards will be based on the 5 judge's scores in the above categories. Decisions are final.
- There will be one Overall Winner combining Judges' Choice and People's Choice votes in both categories.
- There will be four (4) category prize winners: one People's Choice Taste winner, one People's Choice Presentation winner, one Judges' Choice Taste winner, one Judges' Choice Presentation winner.
- Plan on clearing your table and area by 4:45pm.

- **Baker entry deadline:** April 1, 2017 • 14 spaces available. First come, first served. Once spaces are filled, your name will be placed on a cancelation list and you will be called if space becomes available.
- **Location:** Campbell County Public Library (CCPL) • 2101 S. 4J Road, Gillette
- **Setup:** Friday, April 7, 9am-4:45pm and Saturday, April 8, 9am-1pm (setup must be complete ½ hour prior to doors opening to allow for judging)
- **Quantity:** Cupcake size is the baker’s choice – mini or regular. 25 dozen mini size or 7 dozen regular size (regular size to be sliced into quarters to allow for more “tastes”).
- **Cupcake Flavor:** The library will email all registered bakers on April 3 (sooner if all baker spots are filled earlier) revealing fellow bakers’ flavors. Final flavor deadline: April 6.
- **Booth Theme:** Cupcake Wars is CCPL’s National Library Week kickoff event. This year’s theme is “old west.” Bakers are requested (not required) to help celebrate by using an old west decoration theme.
